# Washington D.C. Youth Tour Information & Requirements

## 2018 Tour

### June 8 - 15, 2018

Sierra Electric Cooperative is sponsoring an all-expense paid trip for two students to Washington, D.C. as part of the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association's Government-in-Action Youth Tour. The winners of this essay contest will win an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C. June 8 – 15, 2018.

The Youth Tour has three main objectives:

- To educate youth on all aspects of rural electrification, to promote a better understanding of the value of rural electric cooperatives.
- To provide an opportunity for youth to visit monuments, government buildings and cooperative related organizations to become familiar with the historical and political environment of their nation's capital.
- To provide an opportunity for young adults to meet elected officials to better understand how their federal government works.

Contest Rules:

- Applicant must be a high school junior or senior
- Applicant must be a dependent of an active Sierra Electric Cooperative member and reside in the Sierra Electric Cooperative service territory
- Applicant is required to complete the SEC Youth Tour application and prepare *hand-written* essay responses to the two questions located on the application.

Resource materials that may be helpful to contestants are available at the Sierra Electric Cooperative office or at their school's guidance office. The applicant's essay responses will be judged on the students' knowledge of the subject, originality, composition, neatness and grammar.
