The board of trustees meets the third Friday of the month at 9:00 a.m. in the cooperative boardroom.

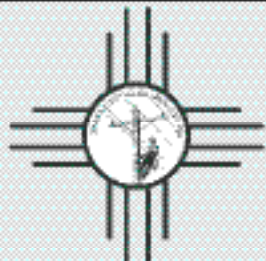
Call Before Your Dig

If you are planning a project that involves digging, including planting a tree or shrubs, make sure you know where your underground lines are. Just "Call Before You Dig"—dial 811 statewide—and we'll come to your home within two days and mark utility line locations. It's smart, safe, free, and it's the law.
