#### **Outdoor Safety Tips**

- Listen to the weather forecast before you venture outdoors. If you know a storm is coming, consider rescheduling the activity for a safer time.
- Stay close to shelter. If you see lightning and then hear thunder within 30 seconds, find cover. If you hear thunder only, lightning probably isn't far behind. Once the thunder stops, stay indoors for 30 more minutes.
- The best shelters are permanent, enclosed buildings, like houses.
